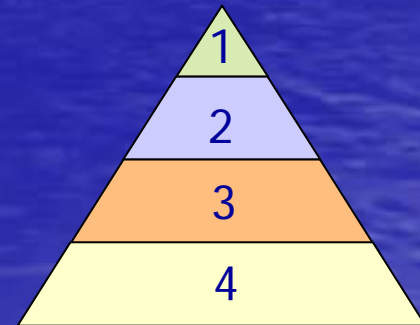

Two Kinds of People

- There are two kinds of people on earth: those who are **celebrated** and those who **celebrate** others
- Pareto's Principle: *"About 20% of people/groups control about 80% of available resources"*
- It's crowded down there. You need to move higher to clear the air and see better... and less competition and complaints too
- **4**: Everybody competes for few
- **3**: Fewer people but limited resources
- **2**: Better than the rest, but not enough
- **1**: No competition. Your own niche

Unlocking Your Potentials

- It is your responsibility to **discover** the platform on which your fulfilment will come. *“If you fail in the days of adversity...”*
 - ✓ What can you do even if you won't be paid?

- There are things you must **remember to forget**: All past experiences that can keep you down or people who have failed at what you wish to do
- Don't **forget to remember** those times that you made *little* progress
- Cultivate your potentials: *“If you can't fly, run. If you can't run, jog – or just walk, crawl, move...”*

Your 3-Day Limit

- Every human has a 3-day limit! Yesterday, today and tomorrow...
- **Yesterday:** Your past can never determine how far you will go in life... *“Yesterday is in the tomb”*

- **Today:** Today is the platform on which you can announce burial arrangements for yesterday's failures, celebration of its successes, and a bold declaration of tomorrow's assured impact
